The last few months have been truly wonderful for Children of Grace Home, so we just want to update and thank you on what has been going on recently.

Building work

As you may know, building work for the orphanage began in April and is almost complete. The home is now finally built along with toilets, windows, doors and the kitchen. Beds will soon be purchased, along with other furnishings, and once these have been fitted, the twelve children will move into their new home.



These boys have been living at our sister orphanage, Children of Faith, next door and have been eagerly waiting for their new home to be built. We are told they have really enjoyed watching all the building work and cannot wait to move in. The home will also be able to accommodate eight more children, who will hopefully be arriving between now and the start of the new year!

Tuk-Tuk

Children of Grace now has its very own auto rickshaw (tuk-tuk). This was donated by Cheree Moyes and her son Luke and will be named 'Bas' in memory of Cheree's father. Having Bas means all the children can travel to church, events, and, if necessary, to the doctors without having to rely on public transport. Weekly groceries and supplies can also be bought now with far greater ease.



Fund Raising Cycle Trip

COG Director Mike Cadge and his friend Alex Hamilton-jones have finished their fundraising cycle from England to Greece. They cycled 1980 miles through 11 countries and over 5 mountain ranges in 6 and a half weeks. They had to endure heavy rain and many bad and busy roads, but were blessed with many great cycle routes and amazing views. Mike and Alex would like to thank everyone who has prayed or donated to the cause which has now raised over £3000. Well done chaps!



The Future

As mentioned above, eight new children will hopefully be arriving at COG in the near future with building expansion being necessary before many more could be accommodated. Around half of the current children have regular sponsors who kindly provide the finances necessary for them to live at the COG home and study at the COF school, whilst spontaneous giving supports the other half. With the new children soon to be arriving at the home we are hoping to try to gain as much long term support as possible so that the future of the home and of the children are secure. It takes just £25 per month to fully sponsor one child to live at the COG home with any and all regular giving being hugely appreciated.
